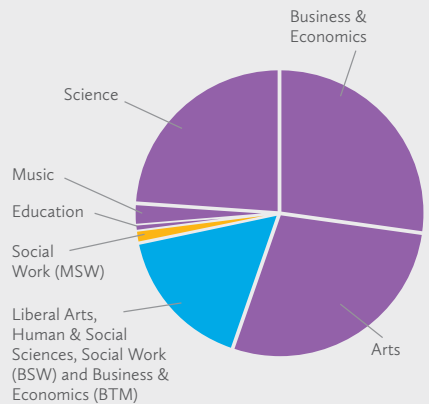
OUR STUDENTS PUT THEORY INTO PRACTICE
